Simon Hackwell explained that the Heart of England Foundation Trust has been chosen by Solihull Care Trust to run community health services in Solihull from 1st April 2011. A board made up of providers in health and social care will meet regularly from April to co-ordinate the redesign of children's services in Solihull.

Karen Murphy explained that Solihull Council is currently matching funding to priorities. There will be a focus on early intervention and prevention and more information will be available shortly.
