The **Metropolitan Borough of Solihull** (in this Order called “the Council”) hereby make the following Order:

The land described in the Schedule below and which is in the area of the Council is hereby designated for the purposes of Section 13(2) of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001.

This Order may be cited as the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Place) (Elmdon and Marston Green) Order 2006 and shall come into force on the 6th day of November 2006.

SCHEDULE

ELMDON AND MARSTON GREEN

All the areas edged red on the plans attached to this Order to which the public have access being within the area bounded by:

The Elmdon area bounded by and including Damson Lane and Damson Parkway and to include the Elmdon Heath Recreation Ground and including Whar Hall Road, Huxbey Drive, Lansdale Avenue, Oakslade Drive, Dalecote Avenue, Inchford Road, Giles Close, Nichols Close, Elmdon Coppice, De Moram Grove, Cloudbridge Drive, Marling Croft, Barnfield Drive, Coppice Road.

The Marston Green area bounded by and including Chelmsley Lane, Station Road, Elmdon Road, Land Lane, and Holly Lane, including Elmdon Court, Elm Farm Avenue, Marston Croft, Carters Close as outlined in the attached plan.
