## Delivering the Arts Award

Langley School in Solihull pioneered the National Arts Award which teachers from Solihull /Music Service have been trained to deliver. The award allows students to get a qualification for their involvement in the Arts.

The Arts Award supports young people to develop as artists and arts leaders and is available throughout England. The Arts Award is a nationally recognised qualification at three levels - Bronze, Silver and Gold.

Any pupil who rehearses with one of Solihull Music Service ensembles would be eligible to take part in either the bronze or silver award and gain a formal accreditation.

The Arts Award also links to the new national curriculum being launched in September 2008, opportunities for music:

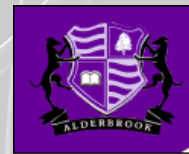
