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### Application deadline - free nursery places in Solihull schools

If you have a child born between 1 September 2008 and 31 August 2009 you can apply for 15 hours free nursery education in a Solihull school starting in September 2012. The deadline for applications is **2 December 2011**. Apply online and find out more at [www.solihull.gov.uk/enrol](http://www.solihull.gov.uk/enrol)

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### Application deadline for reception school places

If you have a child born between 1 September 2007 and 31 August 2008 you must apply for a place in full-time school starting in September 2012. If you live in Solihull apply at [www.solihull.gov.uk/enrol](http://www.solihull.gov.uk/enrol) by **15 January 2012**. If you live outside Solihull please apply through your local Council.

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### Speak to your local neighbourhood police officer
