

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257  
AND PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14**

**THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF SOLIHULL (FOOTPATH U26, HASLUCKS GREEN ROAD,  
SHIRLEY) (NO. 2) PUBLIC PATH STOPPING UP ORDER 2007**


On 20 November 2008 the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above order.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to stop up the public footpath running from Haslucks Green Road at National Grid Reference SP11570, 79479 (point A on the order map) and running south east for approximately 252 metres to National Grid Reference SP11783, 79343 (point B on the order map) and then in a southerly direction for approximately 32 metres to National Grid Reference SP11792, 79314 (point C on the order map) where it meets Public Footpath U27 and create an alternative footpath for use as a replacement to a line running from a point at National Grid Reference SP11565, 79471 (point D on the order map) on Haslucks Green Road and running south east before curving south to SP11626, 79379 (as shown in the approximate position as point E on the order map) and then bearing south east and curving round in a south easterly direction to SP11749, 79286 (point F on the order map) where it meets Public Footpath U27 a total distance of approximately 274 metres as shown on the order map.

A copy of the confirmed order and the order map may be seen free of charge at Solihull Connect (Solihull Library) Ground Floor Library Square Touchwood Court Solihull B91 3RG between the hours of 8.30am to 5.30pm Mondays, 9.00am to 5.30pm Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays, 10.00am to 5.30pm Wednesdays, 9.00am to 1.00pm Saturdays and Solihull Connect within Shirley Police Station 286 Stratford Road Shirley Solihull B90 3AR between 9.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Friday and 9.00am to 1.00pm Saturdays (excluding Bank Holidays). Copies of the order and map are available free of charge to the public.

This order comes into force on the date on which the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull certify that the terms of Article 2 of the order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
