Any individual who joins the LSCB will be offered the opportunity to meet with the Safeguarding Children Business Manager.

By the end of the meeting new Board Members will be able to

- Recognise the key purposes, functions and tasks of Solihull LSCB; including role of Lead Member, LSCB and Director of Children's Services
- Recognise the individual and joint roles and responsibilities of LSCB Members as set out in the Job Description for LSCB Member and LSCB Terms of Reference.
- Identify how to access LSCB Procedures, training and expert advice from the LSCB
- Consider how to ensure organisational support to promote effective engagement with the LSCB
- Consider how to promote two way communication between agency and LSCB
- Recognise their agency's responsibility to ensure the effectiveness of work to safeguard children and young people (single and multi-agency).
