



LEVEL 3: Serious Cases: Writing Individual Management Reviews

Aim

The course is designed to enable managers from Solihull LSCB member agencies who are likely to be asked to write Individual Management Reviews to be able to write reviews so that they positively contribute to the Serious Case Review process.

Objectives

By the end of the course, participants will:-

- Have examined the overall purposes and processes of a serious case review, to give a context for the individual management review, especially the relevance of the scoping of the overall review
- Have examined the key requirements of an individual management review and the requirements of local practice guidance/Solihull LSCB procedures
- Have familiarized themselves with the main requirements about individual management reviews set out in Ofsted Indicators and Working Together (2010)
- Have explored the main challenges for writers of individual management reviews including researching the evidence and evaluating it

Target Group

Senior managers from LSCB member agencies likely to be accountable for commissioning and quality assuring Individual Management Reviews if required, as well as those staff who would produce Individual Management Reviews.
