The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Meriden Drive, Fordbridge) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2011

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Council proposes to make this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and under all other enabling powers. The Order, if implemented, will introduce the following:-

Total Prohibition of Waiting

Meriden Drive – on its eastern side from Fordbridge Road in a generally northerly direction for approx' 109 metres.

Meriden Drive – (i) on its western side from Fordbridge Road in a generally northerly direction for approx' 19 metres; and (ii) from a point 23 metres south of the service road fronting Nos. 198-220 (evens) Meriden Drive in a generally northerly direction to a point 13 metres north of that junction, a distance of approx' 36 metres.

Fordbridge Road - on both sides from a point 22 metres west of Meriden Drive in a generally easterly direction to a point 45 metres east of that junction, a distance of approx' 67 metres.

As a consequence of the above proposals, the current Restriction of Waiting (Monday to Friday, 8.30am to 9.30am and 2.45pm to 3.45pm) shall be revoked along:

Meriden Drive – on both sides from Fordbridge Road in a generally northerly direction for approx' 109m.

Fordbridge Road – on both sides from a point 22m west of Meriden Drive in a generally easterly direction to a point 45m east of that junction, a distance of approx 67m.
