



What is the Early Years Transfer document?

This is a document that our setting will complete with you just before your child transfers to school. It celebrates your child's achievements and provides valuable information to help them settle as quickly as possible.

It will be a good starting point for the teachers working with your child in the Early Years Foundation Stage, providing continuity and progression.

What do I need to do?

It is important that you contribute to the document as you know your child so well. This is a chance for you to comment on your child's progress, strengths and concerns. The school would welcome knowing what your child enjoys most or how they learn best. You might want to pass on something you think is important and helps your child to settle and feel secure.

You will be given a copy of the document to keep.

Health/dietary and Medical Information

Any information passed on to the school will only be done so with your knowledge and agreement. It is vital that the receiving school knows of any requirements, allergies or conditions that might be problematic for your child.

What will the receiving school do with the information?

The school will receive a copy of the document at the end of the summer term.

The information that is passed on will be used as a basis on which to build your child's learning and development.
