Are you a parent or carer of a child with a disability or additional need?

If your child has a disability or additional need it can be really difficult to find someone who might understand. It can sometimes be tough to find out who to talk to and where to go to get help!

Parent Champion Volunteers

Parent Champion volunteers use their own experience as a parent or carer of a child with an additional need and/or disability to help others. They run drop in sessions for 2 or 3 hours a week, which offer parents the opportunity to come together, find solutions and access the information and services they need.

You can get involved with Parent Champion drop in sessions in different ways – from running the sessions to making refreshments or lending a listening ear.

- **Would you like to gain new skills?**
- **Want to meet new people?**
- **Do you want to get involved in feeding parent's views back to services?**
- **Can you spare 2 or 3 hours per week?**

Training and support will be offered to all volunteers to help them fulfill their role.
