The date is required because you will need to declare the interest at meetings for a period of 3 years.

You do not need to register gifts and hospitality which are not related to your role as a member, such as Christmas gifts from your friends and family, or gifts which you do not accept. However, you should always register a gift or hospitality if it could be perceived as something given to you due to your position or if your authority requires you to.

(ix) Any land in your authority's area in which you have a beneficial interest including your home address if you live in the Borough

Note: Give the address or brief description of any land, houses or other building in which you have a proprietary interest in your Council's area. Such as interest includes freehold, leasehold and short tenancies and is one which is for your own benefit or from which you receipt a rent or an income. You do not need to disclose here properties held as a trustee where you receive no benefit but your interest as a trustee may need to be declared at a meeting if you are present at a meeting where such land is the subject of discussion.

(x) Any land where the landlord is your authority and you are, or a firm in which you are a partner, a company of which you are a remunerated director, or a person or body of the description specified in paragraph (vi) above is, the tenant

Note: List here any tenancies of properties in the area where to your knowledge the landlord is your Council and the tenant is a company of which you are a director or in which you have a beneficial interest.

(xi) any land in the authority's area for which you have a licence (alone or jointly with others) to occupy for 28 days or longer;

Note: Give the address of any land which you have a licence to occupy for 28 days or longer and which is in the area of the Council of which you are a member. For example, this would apply to any land you occupy as an allotment or for fishing purposes. Land includes buildings or parts of buildings.
