Solihull Discovery Walks use the outdoors as an extraordinary classroom to learn about local and natural history.

Solihull Discovery Walks usually take place on the third Wednesday of every month and last approximately 2~3 hours.

The walks start and finish at their individual meeting points (see the walk details over)

A monthly Flyer is sent in advance to all members detailing the arrangements and if necessary any last minute changes for the next month's walk.

A small donation of £1 per person is collected which helps our costs.

An extra charge may be incurred at some venues to cover an entry fee or to pay for guides etc. Our monthly flyer will explain any of these charges applicable to the event.

The Number of people on our walks sometimes has to be limited due to constraints imposed by the venue or for safety reasons.
