Solihull Partnership Assembly 2011 *Fast Forward*

Our annual Assembly was held on 25 January and received a positive response from everyone who attended. We would like to thank all those involved for making the evening a positive success.



A total of 131 people attended the event at Solihull College with 36 individual organisations represented, comparable to previous assemblies.

The assembly focused on the projects and activities being delivered by the Partnership, and the difference we are making locally. Presentations were given on a variety of projects, with attendees hearing from some of the people who have benefited from our work.

The theme for the evening was *Fast Forward* which centered around three workshops to help identify key actions required to deliver our refreshed Partnership Priorities – **Ill Health Prevention; Economic Growth; Involved and Inclusive Communities**.

Each workshop provided delegates the opportunity to have a more detailed debate about shaping our work, from the perspective of elected members, local businesses, the police, health and community and voluntary groups.

The Economic Growth workshop was the most notable with local businesses and partners talking about employment and developing young peoples' skills for the

future job market. Each workshop was well attended well received with over 90% of delegates stating the workshops were good or excellent.
