SUBMISSIONS GUIDELINES

Solihull Gallery's G1 space is dedicated to showing high quality, contemporary work from national & regional artists and curators.

We welcome artists to come forward with proposals, especially regional and emerging artists.

The gallery can take a variety of work, from sculpture and 2-D work to video and installation. We particularly welcome proposals that use the space in imaginative ways. We recommend that artists visit the gallery to get an idea of the space.

At this moment Solihull Gallery cannot offer a fee to artists, however there is no hire charge for the gallery space and we offer other forms of support.

Curatorial guidance and professional technical support will be available. The Gallery will also provide marketing for exhibitions in the form of posters, exhibition cards, and inclusion in the Solihull Arts Brochure & E-news and host a private view. The gallery will also aim to run an education programme in the form of talks and workshops that relate to the exhibitions. Fees are available to artists who can offer related workshops or talks.

Our Evaluation Criteria

- Quality of work
- Works of an original or experimental nature are encouraged
- We look for potential for related education workshops/events/activities, although this isn't a requirement of the artist.
- Relevance to gallery audience and geographical location.
- Due to the open plan nature of the space leading onto a busy public library, we can only consider work that is suitable for a family audience!
- Practical suitability for the space
