## The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Priority Area 1) (Duggins Lane, Berkswell) (Speed Limit) Order 2010

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council proposes to make the above mentioned Order under the provisions of Part VI of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and all other enabling powers. The effect of the Order, if implemented, will be to introduce the following speed limit changes:-

### Proposed Maximum Speed Limit - 40mph along:

Duggins Lane      From its junction with Nailcote Lane, in a generally easterly direction, to a point 200 metres east of its junction with Nailcote Lane. A total distance of approximately 200 metres.

The effect of this change will be to introduce a 40mph speed limit on the short section of Duggins Lane between the existing 40mph speed limit on Duggins Lane and the 40mph speed limit which has recently been implemented on B4101 Nailcote Lane and B4101 Spencers Lane.

This section of Duggins Lane is currently unrestricted and, therefore, subject to the national speed limit for single carriageway roads. However, this length is at present subject to a 40mph Temporary Traffic Regulation Order.
