

# SOLIHULL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

## The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Duggins Lane, Berkswell) (40 mph Speed Limit) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2010

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), and being satisfied that the traffic on part of Duggins Lane, Berkswell should be restricted or prohibited, by reason of road safety on or near to the said road, intends to make the above-mentioned temporary Traffic Regulation Order.

The effect of this Order will be to introduce a 40mph speed limit on a short length of Duggins Lane to coincide with the introduction of a new 40mph speed limit on Waste Lane, Nailcote Lane, Spencers Lane and Tanners Lane. The speed limits of C and Unclassified roads within Solihull are currently under review and it is anticipated that a permanent 40mph speed limit on this length of road will be included as part of these proposals. The reason for introducing a temporary speed limit on Duggins Lane in advance of these proposals is to ensure that road safety is not compromised.

The length of road affected shall be Duggins Lane, in both directions, along its route from Nailcote Lane, in a generally easterly direction, to a point 200 metres east of its junction with Nailcote Lane. This section of Duggins Lane is currently unrestricted and, therefore, subject to the national speed limit for single carriageway roads.

The temporary speed limit will be required from 26<sup>th</sup> January 2010 for a period of 18 months.
