The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Elmdon Lane, Marston Green) (Total Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2011

The Council gives notice that it intends to make this Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that traffic should be restricted or prohibited by reason of the likelihood of danger to the general public and road users. The Order will introduce parking restrictions along Elmdon Lane, requested by West Midlands Police to ensure that emergency services access, major incident access to the Birmingham Airport site and general road safety is not compromised along that road due to inconsiderate vehicular parking:

Total Prohibition of Waiting

Land Lane - on both sides from Elmdon Lane for a distance of approximately 22 metres.

Elmdon Lane (fronting Nos 59-63) - on its north eastern side approximately 15 metres south east of its junction with Land Lane, in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 39 metres.

Restriction of Waiting, Monday to Friday, 9-11am and 2-3pm

Elmdon Lane (fronting Nos 7 - 57) - on its north eastern side from approximately 24 metres north west of its junction with Land Lane, in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 310 metres.

These restrictions will take effect from 11 March 2011 and shall remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months or until a permanent Order is advertised and made, whichever the sooner. For further information contact Mr E Bradford, Tel: 0121 704 6477 or email ebradford@solihull.gov.uk
