

# **SOLIHULL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL**

## **The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Wood Lane, Barston) (Prohibition of Driving of Motor Vehicles, Except for Access) Order 2011**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Council proposes to make this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The Order, if implemented, will introduce the following:-

### Prohibition of Driving of Motor Vehicles, Except for Access

Wood Lane, Barston - near to its junction with Brook Green Lane, in the vicinity of No 1 Brook Green Lane (Ordnance Survey approximate grid reference 419376, 278610) to a point approx' 525 metres south of its junction with Barston Lane, in the vicinity of The Bungalow, Wood Lane (Ordnance Survey approximate grid reference 420175, 278186). The restriction is proposed in response to requests from local residents, the local Parish Council and the local Bickenhill Ward Councillors to prohibit driving along this stretch of road, particularly by 4x4's and quad bikes, in order to preserve the road and prevent damage to it. The Prohibition of Driving Order will be enforced by way of lockable gates, located at either end of the affected length of road. Those persons requiring access to frontages between the points of closure will be given access via a key. The Order does not affect access by walkers, horse riders and pedal cyclists.
