

Becoming a SAF Member

Ref: Membership 3.1 Main Constitution

1 Membership sub-committee

- 1.1 A sub-committee consisting of Chairman, Secretary and Membership Officer will co-ordinate the selection process.
- 1.2 The sub-committee may bring in outside expertise.

2 Selection Process

- 2.1 Potential members must submit CV, artist's statement and images to the Membership Sub-Committee
- 2.2 Potential members meeting the SAF criteria guidelines (see 3.0) will receive an invitation to attend the next business meeting to do 2 min presentation about their work
- 2.3 Potential members who have attended a business meeting will be offered associate membership for one year
- 2.4 Full membership will be offered by the sub-committee after completion of successful associate year. This will be a progressive process, which will allow time for new members to assimilate and prove commitment to the group and its aims.

3 Criteria Guidelines for Sub-Committee

- 3.1 Quality of work.
- 3.2 Desire to progress as a professional in their field.
- 3.3 Commitment to SAF by way of reasonable levels of attendance and active participation.
- 3.4 Prepared to give and receive criticism of their own and other members work.
