**LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT 1982**

**STREET TRADING – DESIGNATION OF STREETS**

Notice is hereby given that on 9 November 1998 Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council passed the following resolution:-

That for the purposes of Section 3 and of Schedule 4 to the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982, all streets, roads, footways, forecourts and other areas to which the public have access without payment within the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull be designated as Consent Streets, such designations to take effect on 1 June 1999.

A "Consent Street" means a street in which Street Trading is prohibited without the consent of Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council and the passing of such a resolution will mean that Street Trading will not be permitted without the consent of Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council in the afore mentioned streets, after 31 May 1999.

"Street Trading" means the selling or exposing or offering for sale of any article (including a living thing) in any street, road, footway, or other area to which the public have access without payment.
