**Solihull Spring Festival 2010**

As part of the Spring Festival, the groups listed above will be performing in a concert at Bushell Hall, Solihull School at **7.30 p.m.** on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> March 2010.

There will be rehearsals at the venue before hand as follows –

Vivace	5.00 p.m. (arrive 4.45 p.m.)
Con Brio	5.30 p.m. (arrive 5.15 p.m.)
Junior Strings	6.00 p.m. (arrive 5.45 p.m.)
Millennium Strings	6.30 p.m. (arrive 6.15 p.m.)

Players will remain at the venue between the rehearsal and the concert, so please make sure that your child brings a packed tea and a drink if appropriate. Players should arrive for the rehearsal in concert dress, as there will not be facilities for changing: please consult the conductor of your child's group if you are not sure of the details of concert dress.

Please note that group members will have to make their own way to and from the venue – transport is **not** provided.

There will be no need for you to complete a consent form for this event as you should have completed a global consent form for all Music Service events when registering your child's membership of their group. If you have not already done this please contact your ensemble's conductor/director, who will be able to provide a form for you to complete.

It is expected that every child will take part in this event. If however there are exceptional circumstances that affect your son/daughter taking part I would ask that you tell their conductor/director in writing as soon as possible.

To encourage as many people as possible to come and support the event we have kept the price of tickets as low as we can, and at each concert we will be giving away a free programme. Ticket prices for this year's spring festival concerts are priced as follows –

Bushell Hall £4.75 full price, £2.50 concessions.

### **Purchasing Tickets.**

To make it easier for parents and the public to purchase tickets we have arranged with the Solihull Arts Complex that their box office will sell tickets on our behalf. This means you are able to book tickets over the phone by credit card, or simply by popping into Solihull Library, and if necessary your tickets can be posted to you.
