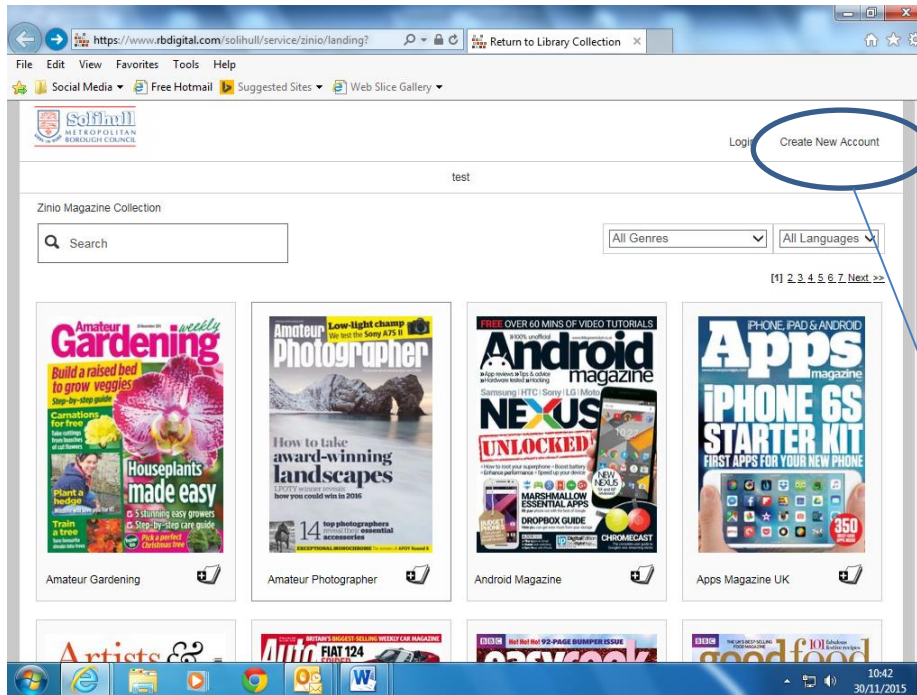


How to download magazines from Solihull Libraries eMagazine service



Click on the link from the Solihull Libraries eMagazine page.

The next few pages show what magazines are available.

If you don't have an account already, click on **Create New Account**.

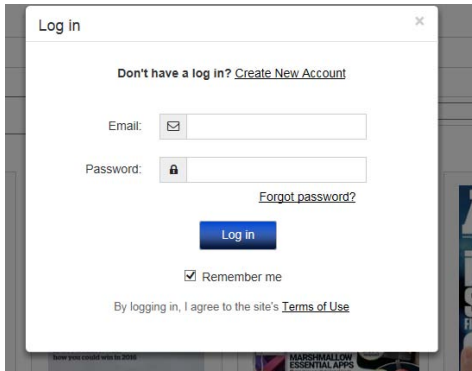

Then fill in the form, with your email address and a password of your choice.

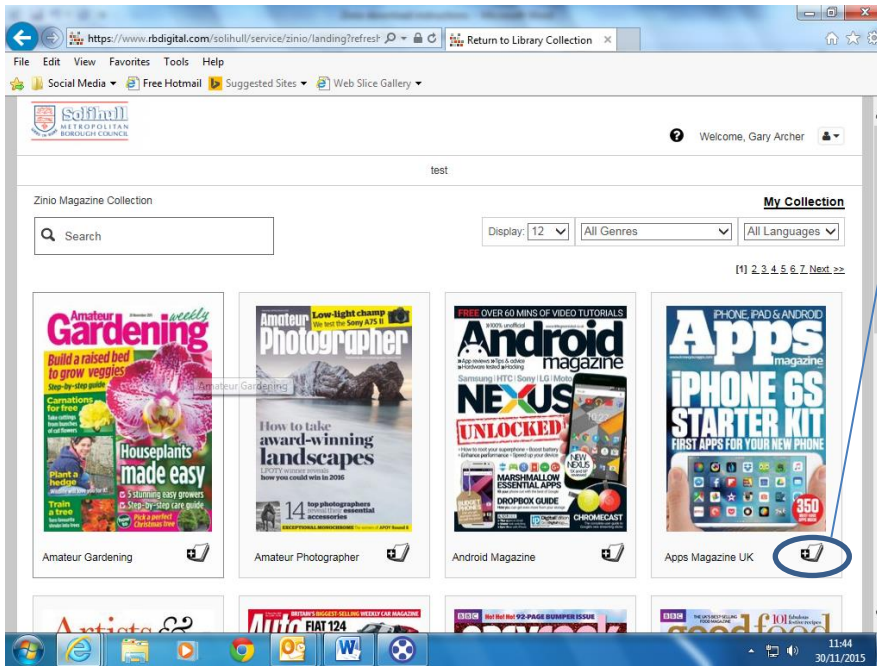
You will use these details to log into your account when you want to download new magazines, you will not need your library card.

Then click **Create Account**.



You will now be asked to **Login** to your account using your email and password.

Don't tick **Remember me** if you are on a shared computer.



You can now download magazines.

To do this, either click on the symbol below each title – this will download the issue showing – or click on the title page to see other issues that are available.

There is no limit on the number of magazines you download, but the system will tell you if you have already downloaded an issue.



Click on **Checkout** to download a magazine if you go to the magazine page. You can also set up an alert to be informed when a new issue becomes available.

Back issues display on the magazine page – there may be several pages of these, all are available for downloading.

If you wish, you can download the free Zinio for Libraries app for your device which will then allow you to read your magazines offline. You will need to log in with the same email address and password that you joined with, and then enter the library collection Solihull Library and Information Service.

As many more magazines are available for purchase from Zinio if you choose, the Zinio for Libraries app would not include these, but another Zinio app is available from the iTunes and Google Play stores.

iPad users

Due to the way the magazines are displayed using Flash, iPad users may find it easier to read the magazines using the Zinio for Libraries app.
