<p>Overall, this FTA concludes that whilst the function has mostly positive impacts the evidence presented suggested a number of areas which need to be looked at on more detail, including;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Further consideration needs to be given as to how to ensure a wider spectrum of the local community are engaged in the programme, particularly actions around engaging women and younger people; • The function needs to begin to consider the impact of the function on people beyond age and sex / gender, to ensure there are no negative impacts; • Further data on breakdown of gender / ethnicity at ward level has shown the need to make links to the BAME community as the population is limited in the project area so there is a need to ensure their views and input into the programme are captured. • Explore any supporting data available from partner agencies. <p>In conclusion, the on-going work to promote the goals of the programme is likely to have a positive impact on the local community.</p>
