The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Beechcroft Road, Chester Road & Kingsleigh Drive) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2020

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via www.solihull.gov.uk/Resident/Parking-travel-roads/roadworks-and-restrictions/tros A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 18 January 2021, will introduce the following:

Total Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time

Beechcroft Road (both sides) – from a point 15 metres north east of its junction with Chester Road, in a northerly direction, to a point 35 metres north of that junction.

Chester Road (southern side) – from a point 15 metres west of its junction with Kingsleigh Drive, in a westerly direction, to a point 20 metres west of that junction.

Kingsleigh Drive (northern side) – from a point 15 metres north east of its junction with Chester Road, in a north easterly direction, to a point 30 metres north east of that junction.
