The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Beechcroft Road, Chester Road & Kingsleigh Drive) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2020

Statement of Reasons

Beechcroft Road & Chester Road are local distributor roads in the Castle Bromwich ward. Kingsleigh Drive is road on a residential estate.

It is proposed to introduce double yellow lines on Beechcroft Road on the approach to the roundabout junction with Chester Road. Waiting restrictions are also proposed on Chester Road (beside St. Mary & St. Margaret's Church) and part of Kingsleigh Road to deter vehicles parking in a manner which is creating an obstruction.

Presently, vehicles are parking on these parts of Beechcroft Road & Chester Road which is creating difficulties with obstruction and congestion. The proposed parking restrictions should alleviate these problems. The restriction on Beechcroft Road should aid local bus services by allowing passengers to board and leave vehicles safely. Presently, buses are being forced to pick up passengers from the middle of the road which in turn leads to congestion and waiting risks.

It is recommended that parking restrictions be advertised as indicated on drawing no. 8667 & 8667/2.

The local Ward Members are aware of the intention of officers to advertise the scheme on Beechcroft Road, Chester Road & Kingsleigh Drive.
