The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Brick Kiln Lane and Widney Lane, Solihull) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2020

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 22 March 2021, will introduce the following:

Total Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time

<u>Brick Kiln Lane (Both Sides)</u> - From its junction with Widney Lane, in a southerly direction, to a point 100 metres south of that junction.

<u>Widney Lane (South Side)</u> - From a point 15 metres west of its junction with Brick Kiln Lane, in an easterly direction, to a point 15 metres east of that junction.
