

Love Solihull Community Litter Picking Guidelines

All individuals carrying out litter picking on Solihull MBC land should follow these guidelines. Activities that do not follow these guidelines are carried out at your own risk.

Keeping Safe on your litter pick:

- Only litter pick if this is something that you feel comfortable and safe doing.
- If using Love Solihull equipment, please ensure you have completed either the Love Solihull Community Litter Picking initiative [registration form](#) (if litter picking as an individual or small informal group) or an event register (if attending an organised community litter pick)
- Only pick up litter using a litter picker - **please do not use your hands**
- We strongly recommend the use of wearing gloves whilst litter picking
- Before going out litter picking, please review the Community Litter Picking Risk Assessment
- Children under 16 years of age should be supervised by their responsible adult at all times
- When litter picking near roads and on rights of way please ensure that you **wear an orange or yellow high-visibility vest** (orange volunteer vests are available from Love Solihull when registering), please refrain from litter picking in the highway, on narrow verges or next to roads with speed limits over 50mph.
- Before taking any photos of people on the litter pick, ensure that they have given consent and understand where the photo may be displayed
- For your safety, **do not enter any water body** or water channel during your litter pick
- We recommend you double bag any disposable gloves and face masks that are found.
- Once you have completed the litter pick, **wash your hands as soon as possible**, also consider carrying hand sanitiser to clean your hands during your litter pick.
- Please report equipment defects or any issues or concerns to Love Solihull or your group leader
- If organising a group litter pick, follow guidance in regards to reducing the risk of COVID transmission (Hands, Face, Space) and recommend that any volunteers taking part take a lateral flow test before attending the event.

Love Solihull bags

- Please use the green 'Love Solihull' bags provided as this differentiates litter waste from fly tipping or side waste
- Up to three Love Solihull bags can be left next to any **SMBC litter bin** and these will be automatically collected by our contractor. If you need to leave more than three bags next to a bin then please complete the [online reporting form](#)
- If you need to leave bags in any location other than next to a council bin, please leave them in an area easily accessible for a vehicle and report the location using the [online reporting form](#)

- For larger community litter picks, the group leader should contact the Love Solihull team in advance of your litter pick to agree collection points. A special collection will then be arranged at the earliest opportunity after your litter pick. The collection point will need to be near to a road, driveway or car park
- Please do not leave bags next to any buildings in case the bags are ignited prior to collection
- Please do not use the Love Solihull bags for green waste (i.e. shrubbery cuttings) without first contacting the Love Solihull team

What to do if you find:

- **Fly-tipping** - Suspected cases of fly tipping should not be moved. Report to SMBC Connect for further investigation and collection
- **Needles** - Please call SMBC Connect for safe collection and disposal
- **Knives / Weapons** – Instruction provided by West Midlands Police:
 - Weapons to be photographed in situ and shared with the Police
 - Location to be recorded and noted so it can be shared with the Police
 - Weapons/knives to be brought to the front office at Solihull Police Station (confirm with the Police desk where the photos and noted location information needs to be sent)
 - Firearms should not be touched and left in situ. Please call the Police for further advice
- **Inaccessible litter on SMBC land** – Please report to SMBC Connect for safe collection

Additional Covid-19 Guidance (updated 19.7.21):

- You should limit the close contact you have with those you do not usually live with and increase close contact gradually.
- If you develop COVID-19 symptoms, please refer to government guidance regarding testing and self-isolation.
- The most important symptoms of COVID-19 are recent onset of any of the following:
 - a new continuous cough
 - a high temperature
 - a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)
- The Government expects and recommends that people wear face coverings in crowded areas such as public transport.
- We would encourage you to continue meeting outdoors, if you do meet indoors please follow the venues requirements regarding social distancing and the wearing of face masks.
- We continue to encourage the use of personal litter picking equipment, if equipment does need to be shared, we recommend appropriate sanitisation between use.
