The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (The Green, Meriden) (Blue Badge Holder Designated Parking Places) Order 2021

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via www.solihull.gov.uk/Resident/Parking-travel-roads/roadworks-and-restrictions/tros. A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 12 August 2021, will introduce the following:

Blue Badge Holder - Designated Parking Places

The Green (north-eastern side) - from a point approximately 7 metres from its junction with Fillongley Road south eastwards for approx. 6.6 metres.

The Green (north-eastern side) - from a point approximately 95 metres from its junction with Fillongley Road south eastwards for approx. 6.6 metres.

To facilitate the above, the following existing restrictions shall be revoked:

The Green (north-eastern side) – (Limited waiting, Mon - Sat, 8am – 6pm 1 hour no return 1 hour) – (i) from a point approximately 7 metres from its junction with Fillongley Road south eastwards for approx. 6.6 metres; and (ii) from a point approximately 95 metres from its junction with Fillongley Road south eastwards for approx. 6.6 metres.
