The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Chadley Close, Solihull) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2021

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via <https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders>. A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 6 January 2022, will introduce the following:

Total Prohibition of Waiting – No Waiting at Any Time

Chadley Close (south-west side) - from a point approx. 10m north-west of its junction with Buryfield Road, north-westwards then south-westwards for approx. 35m.

Chadley Close (north-west side) - from the north-eastern kerb, south-westwards for approx. 18m.

Chadley Close (north-east side) - from a point approx. 45m north-west of its junction with Buryfield Road, north-eastward for approx. 8m.

Revocations

Chadley Close (No Waiting, Monday to Friday 0900 -1100hrs & 1400 – 1500hrs) – from a point approx. 10m north-west of its junction with Buryfield Road for its entirety.
