



52 Things to Support your Child's

Speech and Language Skills.


Syllable Sorter!

A syllable is a unit of speech sounds which are said together when saying a word. Talk about words and how many syllables they have in them.



Make it easier: Clap out the syllables of your child's name and the names of people who are familiar to them e.g Ja...cob, Re...bec...ca etc. Talk about how many claps/ syllables are in the name.

Make it harder: Use pictures or objects and sort them into 1, 2, 3 or 4 syllables words
