

52 Things to Support your Child's Speech and Language Skills.

Hide the spider.

This game is to help your child learn to follow instructions using the concept of 'on, in, under, behind, next to, beside, in front of.

Draw some spiders on a small piece of paper. You will need to find some things that the spider can hide 'in', 'on' or 'under'. Finally, you will need a teddy or a toy to find the spider.



Before you start show your child all the places you could hide the spider. Explain that you are going to hide the spiders for the teddy to find. Get your child to hide the teddy's eyes.

Hide the spiders and your child has to tell the teddy where to look for the spiders,.

Make it easier: Just find one spider at a time.

Make it harder: introduce the words 'before and after'.

Eg. Before you look under the plate, look behind the cushion.

....Or find more than one spider at a time.
