Trregular Verb Ball Toss

Use a ball that's light and safe to throw.

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Refer to the <u>list of irregular verbs</u> as shown.

- Say a sentence using a verb from the list in the present tense eq: 'I can blow a bubble'.
- Then throw/roll the ball to your child.
- Your child then repeats the sentence but using the irregular past tense verb and rolls/throws the ball back to you eq: 'I blew a bubble.'
- If your child does not use the correct verb, sensitively model the correct verb for them, emphasising the correct word slightly.
 - Choose another verb to play the game with and repeat the steps above.
