

I spy with my little eye something the colour...



This is a slightly different version from the 'eye spy' we usually play.

Sit with your child in a quiet area and talk about all the different objects you can see in the room. Make sure your child knows the names of objects you will be choosing when playing the game. Take time to name the colours of the objects too.

Begin the game by saying "I spy with my little eye something that is yellow."

Encourage your child to find and say the name of an object that is yellow in the room. Continue with this using different colours.

Make it easier: Concentrate on two or three colours at once and place a selection of objects that are in these colours in front of your child.

Make it harder: Extend to a two-part instruction. For example, "I spy with my little eye something that is yellow and goes 'quack'." (A duck)
