 - a) the council has issued you with an notice under Section 81 of the Building Act 1984 listing the requirements regarding the work, or
 - b) a period of six weeks as elapsed from the time the Council receives this notice.
3. Failure to give notice or to comply with legislation regarding demolition under the Building Act 1984 may result in you being fined up to £2,500.
4. Please tick the boxes to indicate that copies of this notice have been sent or given to:
 - a) the occupier of any adjacent building(s) to that which is to be demolished,
 - b) National Grid Gas, and
 - c) Central Networks.
