The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Cherrington Way and Glaston Drive, Solihull) (Restricted Parking Zone and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2022

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via <https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders>. A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 7 July 2022, will introduce the following:

Restricted Zone - No Waiting Monday to Friday – 9.00am to 11.00am and 2.00pm to 3.00pm

Cherrington Way - from a point approx. 22m from its junction with Chelveston Crescent for its entire length.

Restricted Waiting - No Waiting Monday to Friday – 9.00am to 11.00am and 2.00pm to 3.00pm

Cherrington Way (both sides) - from a point approx. 13m from its junction with Chelveston Crescent, eastwards for approx. 9m.

Glaston Drive (north-west side) - from a point approx. 4m south-west of its junction with Chelveston Crescent, south-westwards for approx. 89m.

Glaston Drive (south-east side) - from a point approx. 4m south-west of its junction with Chelveston Crescent, south-westwards for approx. 20m.
