The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Solihull Half Marathon) (Road Closures) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2022

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991) and in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994, being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the Solihull Half Marathon can be undertaken in safety.

Sunday 14th August 2022

It will be necessary to introduce the following restrictions to temporarily prohibit all motor vehicles, cyclists and persons riding, leading or driving of horses or any other animals, from entering or proceeding along the lengths of roads specified on the date and at the times indicated below. The restrictions shall not apply to (1) Any vehicle, including registered competitors officially associated with the event displaying the appropriate accreditation; (2) Any vehicle being used in connection with the event including those used for stewarding, crowd management and traffic management purposes or by designated officers displaying the appropriate accreditation; and (3) Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police officer in uniform or an authorised event steward. Pedestrian access to all properties along the route or within the restrictions will be maintained along defined routes throughout the period of the closure. Access will be maintained through the site for Police, Fire and Ambulance Services responding to emergencies.

To facilitate the above, the one-way traffic movement restriction along the length of road specified below shall be temporarily suspended on the dates and times indicated below:

Sections may be opened early in the event that all runners have passed a section but may also be subject to delay in the event of an unplanned emergency or incident which would require the road to be closed beyond the time specified.
