The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Station Road, Balsall Common) (Blue Badge Holder Parking Bay Designation and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2023

The Council proposes to make this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The proposals are:

Proposed Blue Badge Holder Parking Bay Designation

Station Road (south side) - from a point approx. 52 metres north-east of its junction with Kenilworth Road, north-eastwards for approx. 3.3m.

Proposed Restriction of Waiting - 2 hours with no return within 2 hours - Monday to Saturday – 8.00am to 6.00pm

Station Road (south side) - from a point approx. 58 metres north-east of its junction with Kenilworth Road, north-eastwards for approx. 2.5m.

Revocations

As a consequence of the above proposals, the following existing provisions shall be revoked:

Station Road (south side) - Limited Waiting (2 hours, no return 2 hours, Mon - Sat, 8am – 6pm) - from a point approx. 52 metres north-east of its junction with Kenilworth Road, north-eastwards for approx. 3.3m.

Station Road (south side) - Blue Badge Holders Only - from a point approx. 58 metres, north-east of its junction with Kenilworth Road, north-eastwards for approx. 2.5m.
