Please can you:



 Be on time for your transport/taxi - the driver can't wait for you



Be kind to the everyone on your transport/taxi



• Listen to the driver/guide instructions



Keep your items safe



Stay in your seat with your seatbelt on



•Take any rubbish home



 Tell your parent/carer/school if you see someone doing something bad



• Take your medication with you if you need it

Things not to do:



- Don't use bad language
- Don't shout
- Don't make bad signs out the window or to others



- Don't start arguments or bully others
- Don't start fights or 'play fights'
- Don't hurt anyone on your transport/taxi



- Don't distract the driver (unless there is an emergency)
- Don't eat or drink (unless told otherwise)
- Don't spit



- Don't smoke (cigarettes, vapes, e-cigarettes)
- Don't use electronics (phones, iPad, laptops) unless told otherwise
- Don't ask to be taken somewhere that isn't your normal destination

You may struggle with some of these things due to the support you need. Your parent/carer/school can talk to those who collect you to explain why some of these things might be hard for you.

If you don't behave:



 The head teacher of your school/college will be told and you will be reminded how to behave



• If you continue to not behave, your parent/carer will be told



• If poor behaviour continues after that you will not be allowed on your transport/taxi



• If you damage the transport/taxi, your parent/carer will have to pay to fix it.
