



## **EYTAC** checklist for referrers

Please use this checklist to ensure you have completed the Early Years Team Around the Child referral with the right information. Missing information can result in a delay to referral.

steps	Actions	complete
1	Is the child pre-school age? Do you have parent consent? Do they meet the following criteria? They are a <b>Solihull child</b> who has <b>emerging SEND</b> needs.	
	Child 0-4yrs Criteria for referral to EY TAC –  Is the child pre-school age?  Do they meet this criterion?  Do you have parental consent?  3 or more areas of significant developmental delay (communication, fine & gross motor skills, sensory, problem solving/learning/play, personal & social – linked to ASQ and early years child development)  0 - 2 years: 6-month delay in at least 3 areas  2 - 3 years: 6-12 months delay in at least 3 areas  3 years+ - school entry: 12-month delay in at least 3 areas	
2	Are you able to complete the EY TAC referral? This referral process is <b>not for parents</b> to complete (talk to your health visitor) or <b>group-settings</b> (talk to your Area SENCo).	
3	Are all the child's and carers' details included so that the services can <b>contact</b> ? This should include the parent's e mail address.	
4	Have you included your <b>referrer contact details</b> ? If we cannot contact you directly to ask further questions during or post-referral, then this could cause delay.	
5	Have you indicated whose <b>help is required</b> ? SaLT? Home support from the Early Years Team or SISS: SPI?	
6	If this is a <b>re-referral</b> , have the grey additional areas been dated and completed with <b>additional information</b> ?	
7	Have you <b>described</b> the child's needs as well as carers' concerns and wishes? Are the <b>ASQ</b> and child development summaries clear? Have the cut off threshold levels been included? The referral will be read by people who do not work with ASQ daily.	
8	Has the <b>consent form</b> been signed? If not, is it clear who is taking responsibility for consent. Not confirming this in writing will delay the referral.

TAC- Team Around the Child [SEND]

SEND- Special Educational Needs

SENCo- Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator

SaLT- Speech and Language Therapy

SISS- Solihull Specialist Inclusion Support Service

SPI- Sensory and Physical Impairment
