The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Tanhouse Farm Road, Farmstead Road and Farm Close, Solihull) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2023

Statement of Reasons

Through the Council's established Traffic Regulation Order Framework process, Tanhouse Farm Road was identified as a priority location in the Highway Management 2023/24 Works Programme, to be considered for the introduction of new or amended parking restrictions.

The restrictions have been requested by the local community to address obstructive parking at its junction with Farmstead Road.

Following investigation and the receipt of complaints regarding footway parking on Farm Close, it is also proposed to provide parking restrictions in Farm Close and at its junction with Tanhouse Farm Road, to address these existing issues and discourage any displacement parking as a consequence of the wider scheme.

The double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) are proposed to prohibit parking and regulate the kerbside space, to aid road safety and help to facilitate the free passage of all traffic including pedestrians and to improve the amenity of the area.
