The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Various Roads – Balsall Common) (20 MPH Maximum Speed Limit) Order 2023

Statement of Reasons

In accordance with Department for Transport Guidance it is expected that the Council, as the Local Highway Authority, keep speed limits under review with changing circumstances and gives consideration to the introduction of more 20mph limits and zones and over time in urban areas and built-up village streets that are primarily residential.

This has resulted in the above-named proposed Traffic Regulation Order, which has the aim of achieving safe and appropriate driving speeds, preserving, or improving the amenities of the area through which the roads run and to avoid the danger to persons or other traffic using the roads or any other roads, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

It is recommended that the existing speed limits be revoked, and 20mph speed limits introduced as shown on drawing number 9392.
