The Order, which comes into force on 8 March 2024, will introduce the following:

Revocation of 40 MPH Maximum Speed Limit (to become 30 MPH)

<u>B4104 Birmingham Road</u> - from a point approx. 24m west of its junction with Bonneville Close, westwards for approx. 1654m.

Showell Lane - from it's junction with Birmingham Road (B4104), northwards for approx. 26m.
