<u>Solihull Academy</u>	Solihull Academy Main School	Year 8 to 11	Long / Mixed	109	For students at risk of exclusion or unable to access their current provision, short or long term.
	Pathfinder	Year 7 and 8	Short / Long	16	Students that are at risk of exclusion or unable to access their current provision, short or long term.
<u>Daylesford Academy</u>	Daylesford	Year 7 to 11	Long / Mixed	35	Vulnerable pupils who cannot manage in a mainstream setting. Those who have special educational needs including emotional regulation / mental health difficulties, ADHD / ASD / Dyslexia (diagnosed and undiagnosed), Drugs and alcohol issues, Experience of DV, low school engagement and attendance.
	The Apollo Centre	Year 1 to 6	Short / Mixed	20	For students who have been permanently excluded / 6 th day provision needs / at risk of exclusion or are presenting undiagnosed SEND needs and require additional support services. A short stay group and those that may require a longer stay due to their complex nature. Service offers “outreach” and on-site
<u>REFRESH</u>	Refresh	Year 1 to 6	Short (2 terms)	18	Cohort model. This is a short-stay intervention provision for pupils who need support, beyond that usually available at SEN support, to manage the social, emotional, and environmental demands of a mainstream setting. Pupils attend four days per week and attend their home school with outreach support one day per week. Dual rolled remaining on home school role.
<u>SEMH High Needs Pathway</u>	SEMH High Needs Pathway	Foundation to Year 11	2 terms	90	Proactive support for pupils with SEMH at risk of exclusion
<u>Triple Crown Centre</u>	Triple Crown Centre	Year 7 to 11	Short	40	Short term provision away from mainstream settings due to medical needs. Dual rolled remaining on home school role.
<u>Tudor Grange Academy Solihull</u>	The Elms	Year 7 to 9	Short	8	For students whose attendance has dropped significantly and would benefit from smaller environment to support with reintegration back into their mainstream school. Dual rolled remaining on home school role.
<u>Tudor Grange Primary Academy Yew Tree</u>	Yew Tree Cedars	Year 1 to 6	12 weeks	8	For students with an SEMH need. Part of the “Graduated Approach,” assessments may identify the need for an EHCP. Dual rolled remaining on home school role. Provision over 4.5 days a week with 0.5 x day at home school.
AV-1 Robots	n/a	Year 1 to 11	Short	n/a	Enables children who cannot attend school to access lessons with their peers remotely
Tuition	Tuition	Year 1 to 11	Short	n/a	Individual tuition as a short-term education offer
