The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (St Bernards Road, Stoneleigh Road and Adjoining Roads, Olton) (Total Prohibition of Waiting, Restriction of Waiting and Loading) Order 2024

Statement of Reasons

Through the Council's established Traffic Regulation Order Framework process, St. Bernards Road and its surrounding roads were identified as a priority location in the 2023/24 works programme to be considered for the introduction of new or amended parking restrictions.

The new and amended restrictions are proposed in response to local concerns and aim to regulate on-street parking. They will address obstructive parking at school drop off and pick up times. This will aid the free passage of traffic and preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

The proposed 'No Waiting, Monday -Friday, 8:30 - 9:30am and 3-4pm' (single yellow line), will discourage obstructive parking at school pick up/drop off times. The 'No Waiting at any Time' (double yellow lines) are proposed to protect the junction following the possible displacement of parking.
