The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008 (Amendment No. 27) Order 2023

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via <https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders>. A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective.

The Order, which comes into force on 7 April 2024, will designate a new off-street parking place and establish its conditions of use and the charges to be paid in connection with its use:

Poplar Road, Solihull Multi Storey Car Park (former M&S Car Park) (Operational Change from Pay on Foot to Pay and Display including 2024/25 Tariff Increases)
