Case studies/examples:

- 1. Support our Employability Workshops for Young People
 - The Council's Employment and Skills team offers a two-day employability workshop for young people, aimed at preparing those who are furthest from the labour market with the necessary skills to undertake work
 - This includes confidence building, team working, transferable skills etc.
 - Your business support would be extremely valuable in providing financial and/or other support towards these workshops. This could be in the form of -
 - Sharing your expert advice to young people within these workshops using expertise from your sector to give real life examples
 - Supporting the delivery
 - Providing resources to support the delivery e.g. stationary, electronic items, training materials
 - Offer follow on activities to help people get more work ready, eg, provide skills on personal budgeting, setting up a bank account, preparing to move away from home
