Proposed Maximum 30mph Speed Limit (to replace existing Maximum 40mph Speed Limit)

Barston Lane - From its junction with Eastcote Lane, in a westerly direction for a distance of 695m.

Barston Lane - From its junction with Knowle Road, in an easterly direction for a distance of 2472m.

Eastcote Lane - From its junction with Barston Lane, in a north easterly direction for a distance of 331m.

<u>Friday Lane</u> - From its junction with Barston Lane, in a north westerly direction for a distance of 427m.

Knowle Road - From its junction with Barston Lane, in a south westerly direction for a distance of 400m.

Oak Lane - From its junction with Barston Lane to its cul-de-sac end (entire length).

Ryton End - From its junction with Barston Lane to its cul-de-sac end (entire length).

Walsal End Lane - From its junction with Eastcote Lane to its cul-de-sac end (entire length).
