The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (A41 Corridor – Various Roads) (20mph and 30mph Maximum Speed Limits) Order 2025

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 14 July 2025, will introduce the following:

Maximum 20mph Speed Limit (to replace existing Maximum 30mph Speed Limit)

<u>The entire lengths of</u> - Seven Star Road service road (fronting 55 to 171), Seven Star Road service road (36 to its junction with Thornby Avenue), Baginton Close, Beauchamp Road, Manor Road and Thornby Avenue.

Maximum 30mph Speed Limit (to replace existing Maximum 40mph Speed Limit)

<u>Lode Lane</u> - From a point 15m south of its junction with Seven Star Road, to a point 15m north of that junction.

Seven Star Road - From its junction with Lode Lane, in a westerly direction for approx. 790m.

Solihull Bypass - From its junction with Lode Lane, in an easterly direction for approx. 46m.
