How long will it take for lavender walk pergola to be removed

We anticipate the works will take three days and will be undertaken as sympathetically as possible

How long will it take for the garden of tranquillity pergola to be removed

We anticipate the works will take five days as and will be undertaken as sympathetically as possible

How do I know which section of the cemetery my memorial is?

We have a map of the site which can be found below.

Can I visit whilst the works are taking place

Access will be restricted so that the pergola can be removed safely, but we will try to keep disruption to a minimum.

How will you make sure my memorial doesn't get damaged?

We will be taking photos before, during and after the works and working carefully to prevent damage to any memorials in this location

Will you be moving my memorial?

Memorials may be temporarily moved to prevent damage. We will not be permanently removing any memorial, and we will re-instate any memorials we have moved temporarily

Lavender walk can be found adjacent to the flower terrace, and we have provided an extract of the map detailing this.

The Pergola is being fully removed and will not be replaced with an alternative.



The Garden of Tranquillity can be found to the right of the main exit drive, once past the chapel. An extract of the map has been provided below detailing this. The Pergola here will be replaced with upright Wooden Posts with rope strung between them.
