NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Council, in accordance with Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, intends to construct and commission two new Pedestrian (Zebra) Crossing facilities at the location specified below:

Moorend Avenue, Chelmsley Wood – (i) just north of Ely Close and (ii) just south of Willow Way.
